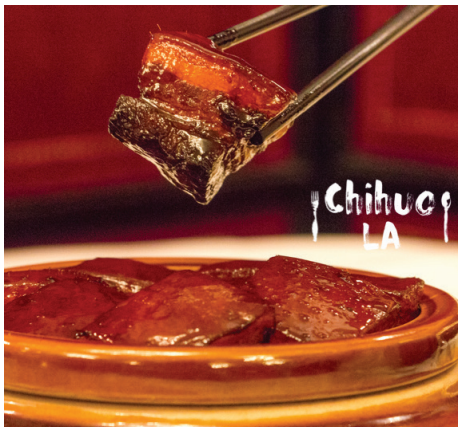

## “The Julia Child of Taiwan” Brings Her Expertise to the SoCal Food Scene

### CAREER

In Taiwan, I had a radio program for people who missed their hometown cooking. They would call in and I could offer advice on how to replicate it.

I moved my kids to the United States for their education and started a radio show on AM 1300 in Los Angeles, “What to Eat Today”. I had talk shows, one called “Guess Who’s Coming to Dinner”. I also advertise for top-quality cooking brands, judge cooking contests, and arrange TV shows. I did one called “Good Men Can Cook”, and another about *boazi*, steamed stuffed dumplings. People use the word 土包子, “*tu baozi*”, to mean uneducated, countryside people, so I said, “Why not do a cooking show on excellent *baozi* to give it some respect?”

### THE ESSENTIALS

For food to be good, in Chinese we say “色, 香, 味” – “presentation, smell, taste”. For me, flavor is the most essential thing.

But presentation needs the five colors: black, red, green, white, and yellow. And not just for the look. Each color is good for a different organ: black *mu er* (wood ear mushrooms) for your kidneys, green spinach or broccoli for your liver, red foods for your heart. Yellow gets overlooked, but it’s good for your spleen.

### EAT DRINK MAN WOMAN

I became the cooking consultant for Ang Lee’s film “Eat Drink Man Woman”. [Possibly the best movie about food of all time. -ed.] Lee needed a character for his leading actor who knew *all* Chinese cooking, so I said “Only I can do that!” We had been hiring chefs from across China’s eight main cuisines. If you go

to an expert chef, he’ll know how to cook Sichuanese or Shanghainese or Cantonese, but nobody can do all of it. Even back in Taiwan, I had already been convening chefs from the different traditions so they could learn from each others’ techniques. Lee called me “the Julia Child of Taiwan!”

We got invited to the Oscars for Best Foreign Film, and at Cannes and the Ghent Film Festivals in France and Belgium.

### SAN GABRIEL VALLEY

I always tell my foreign friends to come to the San Gabriel Valley. We say that it covers the “Eight Traditional Cuisines” of China. It’s like a little hometown for every kind of Chinese food. The food is good, the people are kind, and authentic food is inexpensive. San Francisco and New York have good food, but it’s too expensive!

### LAS VEGAS

I was the founder and owner of the Royal Star at the Venetian. In 2002 and 2003, we were selected as the best Chinese food in town.

### PEONY PAVILLION

Once, Professor Kenneth Hsien-yung Pai (UC Santa Barbara) hosted a performance of the opera “Peony Pavillion” in Hollywood, and they asked me to do their after-parties. Over 200 people showed up, performers, movie stars, academics! We borrowed a couple vans to bring all the equipment, and had to do all the cooking on his balcony. We did congee one night and then wonton soup with shark, pork stomach, chicken, and eggs. And the last night we steamed beef noodles and dumplings. I still run into people when I go to Santa Barbara who say, “I remember those parties!”

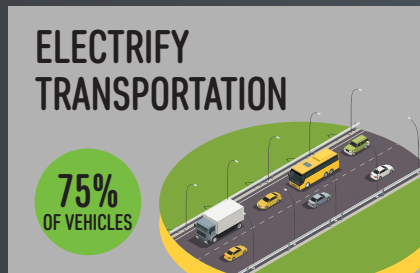
